Rasoul Rasoulipour (Ph.D.) is a faculty member of the Department of Philosophy and the Dean of the Faculty of Letters and Humanities at Kharazmi University, Tehran, Iran. He was a visiting scholar at Oxford University in 2005 and 2006, and the Director of the Center for Interreligious Dialogue in Tehran, Iran, from 2006 to 2009. During these years, he had many chances to participate in interfaith dialogues held in different countries; such as Italy, Germany, France, Switzerland, Ukraine, Lebanon, Thailand, Philippines, and Japan.

Rasoulipour went to the University of Notre Dame, IN, USA in 2007 as a visiting scholar and continued his work over there as a Visiting Associate Professor at the Theology Department and then, Institute for Church Life, Notre Dame, until 2013.

He is the author of *Sacredness of the Other, Love, and Healing* (2013) funded by the Fetzer Institute, MI, USA. The story of his dialoguing style of life has been elaborated in *Interreligious Friendship after Nostra Aetate* (Macmillan, 2015, Ch.7).
