Once you have confirmed the "Terms of Use", you can use "Salzburg surft!" for a limited time within a 100-meter radius of the hotspot (between midnight and 5 am, the WiFi is turned off automatically). Hotspots are located in *Mirabell Gardens*, at the town hall on the Getreidegasse, on *Mozartplatz, Kapitelplatz, Kajetanerplatz squares* and at *Marko-Feingold-Steg bridge*.
